

Keys to Math Success: Teacher 2 Checklist

Getting the Class Ready

- [] Stand during the session, just like Teacher 1.
- [] Turn off or on the lights when needed.
- [] Set up the projector and PowerPoint every time before it's time to use it.
- [] Turn off the projector and lights each time after the slide is done.
- [] Wipe the board quickly when needed.

Helping the Students

- [] Write down all student names.
- [] Watch who is taking part in class and who isn't.
- [] Talk to quiet students privately and **kindly encourage** them to join in more.
- [] Make sure no one is sleeping, playing with phones, or putting bags on desks.

Checking Books During Break

- [] Ask students to leave their books on your desk during break.
- [] Put tick marks on their work quickly.
- [] Mark numbers that are written badly and give short advice or kind notes.
- [] Add stars or stickers when they try hard or do well.

Helping Teacher 1

- [] Watch Teacher 1 closely to keep the method correct.
- [] If something seems off, quietly let Teacher 1 know.
- [] **Keep track of time** and help Teacher 1 move on if needed.
- [] Remind Teacher 1 if time is being wasted.
- [] Let the company know how Teacher 1 is doing.

Supporting Students During Class

- [] If a student is lost, quietly explain again or give a small example.
- [] Help count students' speed-writing if needed.
- [] Make sure everyone is following class rules.

- [] After break, help students settle down quickly.
- [] If someone still doesn't understand after class, offer to teach it again **another** day.

Handling Student Needs

- [] **Give permission** for bathroom breaks, pens, calculators, etc.
- [] Keep class moving so Teacher 1 is not interrupted.
- [] Bring water to students or Teacher 1 if needed.
- [] Give out worksheets or handouts when needed.

Cheering Up and Motivating

- [] Help students understand why they got a question wrong.
- [] Start claps or give small praise when students do something well—without stopping the class.
- [] Keep the class environment happy, kind, and focused.

Keeping Things Clean and Tidy

• [] Make sure desks are wiped and the **classroom is neat** during breaks.

Stepping In (If Needed)

- [] If many students are confused, help explain—but do it kindly and respectfully.
- [] **Never** make Teacher 1 feel bad when helping out.
